

NCCER Instructor Certification Training Program for Craft Instructors

The Instructor Certification Program is taught by National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) certified Master Trainers. Any craft instructor who plans to teach the Contren Learning Series Curriculum and to have their students entered into the NCCER's National Registry must be certified by a Master Trainer and sponsored by an NCCER sponsor. The Construction Education Foundation of Georgia (CEFGA) is the sponsor in Georgia.

Topics include: Introduction to the NCCER and CEFGA; How Learning Occurs; Communication for Learning; Group Dynamics and Leadership; Administration and Classroom Management; Using the Contren Series of Learning; Teaching Strategies; Instructional Aids; Evaluation Techniques; and Giving a Short Presentation

The Accreditation Workshop provides the necessary information for an instructor to prepare his program for CEFGA Industry Accreditation. It includes sample materials as a guide to document the program.

The OSHA/NCCER 10-Hour Safety Workshop dual credentials the participant in both OSHA 10-Hour Safety and NCCER Construction Site Safety Orientation. This workshop is invaluable in helping the instructor prepare the students in construction safety which is an integral part of the curriculum that is expected to be taught.

Upon completion the participant will receive the ICTP Certification, the OSHA 10-Hour Certification and the NCCER Construction Site Safety Orientation Certificate.

Note: *In order to obtain NCCER Craft Instructor Certification, applicants must have at least one of the following qualifications:*

- o experience at a minimum level of a journey person in their craft
- o minimum of three years experience as a certified teacher in a vocational/technical or maintenance related training program.
